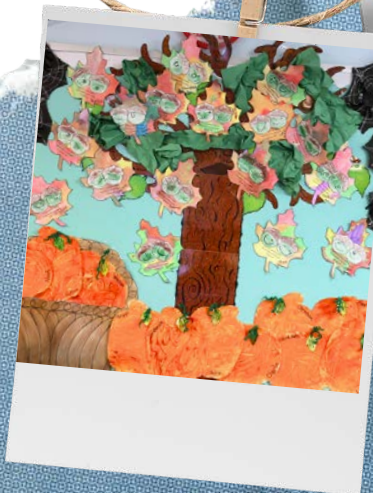

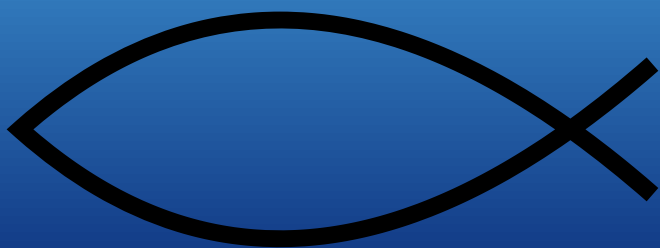
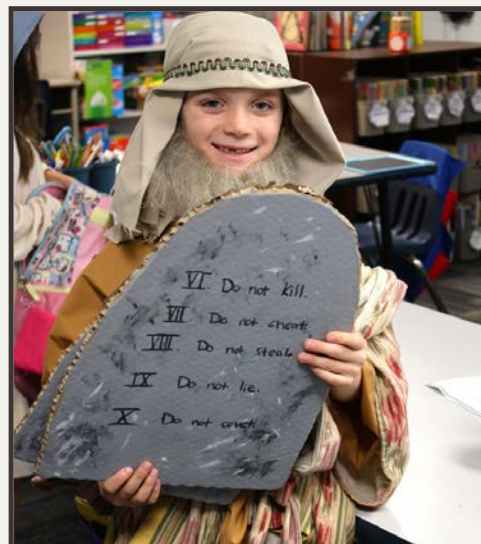

## BCA NHS Members Bring Joy and Connection to Twin Lakes Retirement Community

On a bright afternoon in Burlington, the members of the National Honor Society (NHS) at Burlington Christian Academy gathered their bingo cards, markers, and enthusiasm to head over to Twin Lakes Retirement Community. Their goal: to spend meaningful time with residents, share laughs, and build bridges across generations.

The mood was immediately warm when the students arrived. At Twin Lakes, several residents greeted them with smiles, curious to see the younger visitors. As the bingo session began, the students took turns calling numbers, helping residents mark their cards, and engaging in light-hearted conversation. The atmosphere was full of gentle competition, chuckles at near misses, and delight when someone shouted "Bingo!"



For the BCA NHS members, the visit was about much more than a game. It was an opportunity to serve the community, deepen empathy, and approach leadership with compassion. One student noted afterward, “It just felt good to see someone’s face light up when they won or even when they just got the number right.” Another added that she appreciated listening to the stories the residents told—stories of growth, history, and the joys and challenges of a long life.

From the residents’ perspective, the visit brought something special—a sense of connection to the younger generation, a reminder that community doesn’t end with age, and an invitation for fun when perhaps the day might otherwise be quiet. One resident said, “Having young people here reminds me I still have things to share—and things to learn.”

The partnership between BCA’s NHS and Twin Lakes has already planted seeds for future visits. The students and staff discussed follow-ups: perhaps a reading hour, arts & crafts, or even a music-sharing session. The key takeaway: intergenerational interaction enriches both sides.

In a world that too often segments people by age, BCA’s NHS members offered something simple yet profound—presence, kindness, and the willingness to share time. At Twin Lakes, the bingo cards may only cover five rows and five columns, but the connections made in those 60 minutes were far broader.
