Each spring, our students in grades 1-8 take a nationally recognized standardized test, and our elementary students consistently score above both state and national averages. Year after year, BCA students rank in the top 15% nationwide, reflecting the strong foundation and academic excellence built in our classrooms.



Curriculum

Our elementary program is designed to spark curiosity, build confidence, and nurture a lifelong love for learning. We lay a strong foundation in academics, spiritual growth, and character development, preparing students to thrive in middle school and beyond.

Our reading program grows with students as they do, beginning with phonics, fluency, and comprehension in the early grades, and expanding to novel studies, poetry, and non-fiction in the upper grades. Along the way, students not only sharpen their skills but also discover the joy of reading.

Faith is woven into everyday life through Bible lessons, prayer, scripture memorization, and chapel services. Most importantly, our teachers lead by example, modeling Christ-like character and guiding students in their own spiritual journey.

From history, math, and science to art, music, and physical education, our classrooms are filled with hands-on learning that inspires creativity, critical thinking, and healthy habits. Technology and Spanish classes further expand students' skills, while daily recess gives them time to grow socially and physically.

Beyond the classroom, students can take part in enrichment opportunities like the ACSI International Math Competition, our Elementary Enrichment Program, and Student Leadership Academy. Fifth graders participate in the DARE program, and all students enjoy educational field trips that bring learning to life.

For those who need extra support, The Bridge Program partners with families through early intervention programs such as Barton Reading & Spelling, Search & Teach for kindergarten/NILD, Foundations in Sounds and Math Club for developing number sense.

With a balance of strong academics, spiritual growth, and meaningful experiences, BCA equips students not only for academic success but also for lives of faith, leadership, and service.

Biblical Worldview

Every subject is taught through the lens of a biblical worldview, grounding students in the truth of God's Word. Our curriculum helps students not only understand God's story but also learn how to live it out in their daily lives.

Bible instruction is an essential part of the school day, with an emphasis on scripture memorization, servant leadership, and opportunities for community service. Beginning in third grade, students are introduced to the SOAP Bible Study Method—Scripture, Observation, Application, and Prayer—equipping them with practical tools to engage with God's Word on a deeper level.
