Here's how your gift to the BCA Annual Fund will make an immediate impact:



In 1947 the Veterans of Foreign Wars established our Voice of Democracy audio-essay program to provide high school students with the unique opportunity to express themselves in regard to a democratic and patriotic-themed recorded essay. Each year, nearly 25,000 9th through 12th grade students from across the country enter to win their share of more than \$1 million in educational scholarships and incentives awarded through the program.

The national first-place winner receives a \$35,000 scholarship paid directly to the recipient's American university, college, or vocational/technical school.
