

BURLINGTON CHRISTIAN ACADEMY

History

Burlington Christian Academy (BCA) was established in 1978, and is conveniently located in central North Carolina, between Greensboro and Durham. BCA is the largest non-public school in Alamance County. Academy enrollment is composed of 879 students from Alamance County and four surrounding counties in grades PK-12. Diversity is important as we serve students from every socio-economic background, in addition to international students from an average of five countries each year. The class of 2010 was the first graduating class from Burlington Christian Academy's newly established high school, which is now in its eighteenth year, with an enrollment of 155 students. The academy is accredited by both AdvancED /Southern Association of Colleges and Schools, and the Association of Christian Schools International.

Academic Excellence

BCA has a long-standing reputation of providing students with an excellent, rigorous, college preparatory education within the context of a Christian worldview. BCA students traditionally score significantly above district and state levels on annual Advanced Placement Tests and have exhibited strong performances on the PSAT, as well as the SAT and ACT for college admissions. The average class size in the BCA High School is fifteen students per class. There are twenty-five high school faculty and staff members, and approximately fifty percent hold or are working toward advanced degrees.

Curriculum

The BCA curriculum includes twenty-four honors courses and fourteen Advanced Placement courses, some of which are offered on a rotating schedule, i.e. not every year. Courses are provided on a traditional year-long schedule (seven 50 minute periods per day). The Academy's required courses dictate that a student will be limited to one or two AP courses in the 9th-10th grade years, and typically hit a maximum of nine - ten AP courses over four years. The requirement of a Christian Foundations course each year also limits a student's options for electives, additional foreign language classes, or additional core classes.

Students have the opportunity to complete third and fourth levels of Spanish through Alamance Community College, and may also enroll in additional college courses through the dual enrollment programs at Alamance Community College, Elon University, and The College at Southeastern, when scheduling allows.

From March - May 2020 students completed a full schedule of classes online - with consistent numerical grading. For the 2020-2021 school year, BCA operated on an in-person seven period day schedule, with an online option. Ninety percent of high school students attended in person. In the 2021-current school years, BCA has operated in-person full-time.

In 2023 Burlington Christian Academy had 22 students awarded varying levels of AP Scholar Awards.


