<b>SEARCH &amp; TEACH (One-on-One Sessions)</b>	SEARCH: An early intervention assessment used to identify students who may be at risk for reading difficulties.  TEACH: A targeted program designed to strengthen foundational skills necessary for reading success.	All kindergarteners are assessed free in Aug–Sept; students scoring 1–5 can benefit from TEACH interventions.	Sessions run Nov–early May 2–3 times/week for 30 minutes.  Additional sessions, if needed, are offered the following year Aug–Oct.	2x/week: \$575/year 3x/week: \$850/year Additional sessions 2x/week: \$230  Minimum 35 sessions
<b>BARTON (One-on-One Sessions)</b>	A reading and spelling program, based on Orton-Gillingham research, designed to help students with dyslexia and other reading or spelling challenges.  Offered in person or virtually	Kindergarten & up Students must pass the screener to start Barton; those who don't will begin in Foundation in Sounds.	Sessions are held twice a week, lasting 50–60 minutes each.	\$1,500/year, payable \$150/month (Aug–May)
<b>FOUNDATION IN SOUNDS (One-on-One Sessions)</b>	A foundational program in phoneme awareness for those students who do not pass the Barton screener. It is assumed the student will start Barton once Foundation In Sounds is completed.	Kindergarten & up	Sessions are held 3–4 times a week for 30 minutes each. This is a pre-course to Barton, if needed.	Minimum 52 sessions
<b>MATH CLUB</b>	After school club that works with a group of up to 4 students who are struggling with math number sense and/or the fundamentals of math.	Grades 1–5	Mid-September to early May, sessions are held twice a week from 3:00 to 3:45 p.m. by semester	\$220 per semester, payable \$55/month for 4 months; 20 sessions per semester
<b>NILD Educational Therapy (One-on-One Sessions)</b>	Goes beyond traditional tutoring. It targets the thinking and learning processes behind academics, helping students strengthen cognitive skills and confidence through individualized, research-based strategies.  Offered in person or virtually	Grades 1–8	Sessions are held twice a week, lasting 80 minutes each.	Cost will be determined during consultation

## FINANCIAL INFORMATION

### PAYMENT POLICIES

All families **MUST** set up an automatic draft payment plan using the FACTS Tuition Management System and maintain a valid and active account on file. **FACTS Tuition Management is the only accepted method of payment for all tuition and fee charges.**

**Returned Check Fees:** There will be a \$30 return payment fee for any returned item charged by FACTS.

**Late Fees:** A \$45 late fee will be assessed if a payment returns unpaid for any reason.

**Suspension for Non-Payment:** Students will not be allowed to attend class when their accounts become 30 days delinquent. Students are subject to dismissal if their account is not brought current within one week of their suspension. Student records will not be released until overdue accounts are satisfied.
